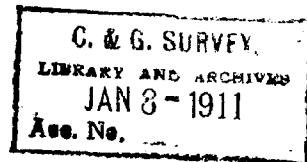

Additional soundings were made to supplement the soundings shown. The survey is not a complete development of the area, but should be used in conjunction with the hydrographic sheet of 1853. And the results of the Engineer Corps U.S. Army.

The enlargement is by doubling, by means of proportional dividers, the positions as placed on a scale of 1-20,000. The buoys are shown, as placed on August 19<sup>th</sup> 1911, and as the positions are evidently bad, the positions as later determined, should be obtained or the attention of the Bureau of Light Houses should be called to the need for replacing the buoys, and determining their new positions.

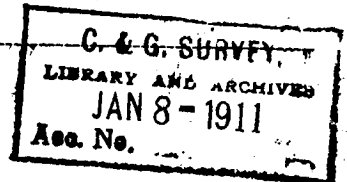
