The tide reducers for Hydrographic Sheet No. 563, Carquines Strait, Calif., by party of James Alden in 1857, have been examined and appear to accord with the original note entered on the sheet, "The plane of reference is the mean of the lowest low water of each 24 hours", which is now called the mean lower low water.

It is recommended that the note of June 1, 1926, stating that, "To reduce to mean lower low water, add 0.25 foot to the soundings", be cancelled.
