Subject: Tide Reducers for Hydrographic Sheet No. 573.

Referring to sounding records for Hydrographic Sheet No. 573, an examination shows that the tide reducers for the work in San Antonio Creek, covering the period 10:10 to 10:55 on February 28, 1857, as entered in the sounding books were referred to a datum reading 1.4 feet on the tide staff at Oakland, California. From such computation as is possible from the limited tidal data available for that period, this may be taken as a sufficiently close approximation to mean lower low water.
