January 17, 1918, I have had examined the records for

HYDROGRAPHIC SHEET 690

Crescent City Harbor, California, by James Alden in 1859.

We find that the datum used was approximately 1.5
feet below mean lower low water, and corresponds to a
reading of 0.1 foot on the Crescent City tide staff.

To refer the plotted soundings to mean lower low
water, they should be increased by 1.5 feet.
