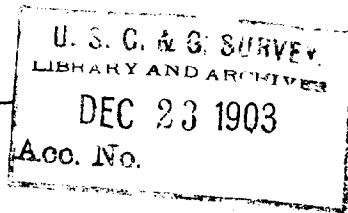

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Descriptive Report



Saco Bay, Maine - Nov. 3, 1903.

Signals, Bluff, Beach, and Wharf also Pipe (a large standpipe on Punt's Neck) were determined by plane table using Wood Id. St. No. + Cape Elizabeth St. No. as a base and the shore line from station Beach to the pier put in by same means.

A survey of Little River Rock shows a ledge about 150 meters long running about N.W. + S.E. with $2\frac{3}{4}$ feet at S.E. end and $3\frac{1}{4}$ ft. at N.W. end and 9 feet between. This ledge is not buoyed.

Red Spar buoy No. 2 is about 1200 meters to the eastward of this ledge and ~~marks~~ a small pinnacle rock with $12\frac{1}{2}$ feet on the shallowest part and from 4 to 6 fathoms around it.
