

## HYDROGRAPHIC SHEET No. 905.

The tide reducers for Hydrographic Sheet No. 905, Suisun Bay, Calif., by party of Edw. Cordell in 1866 and 1867, have been examined and appear to accord with the original note stating that the soundings "show the depth at the mean of the lowest low water of each 24 hours", which is now called the mean lower low water.

It is recommended that the following note of July 3, 1924, "To reduce the soundings to the plane of mean lower low water add 1.5 feet to the soundings as plotted", be cancelled.
