Descriptive Report

Richmond, Kennebec River, Maine  
Survey of ledge vicinity of Southard's  
Wharf -

Subsketch on original hydro<sup>c</sup> sheet No. 1064

This is a small rocky ledge extending from N.E. to S. of red buoy, southeast about 100 meters from Southard's Wharf, Richmond, Me.

The corners of this wharf, and two fence corners on east side of river and one spire in Richmond were identified and from these flags for hydro<sup>c</sup> stations were determined by plane table.

The ledge has  $1\frac{1}{4}$  feet on it at M. L. W. and is probably bare at extreme low tide.
