An examination of the sounding records for H-1170 reveals that there are no recorded positions for the sunken rock symbols formerly charted in the general vicinity of Round Rock in lat. $41^{\circ} 14.08'$, long. $72^{\circ} 52.68'$. The sunken rock symbols indicate the character of the bottom as expressed by the words rocky and stony in the sounding records and have been revised on the smooth sheet by the substitution of the abbreviation rky for the symbol.

A tracing showing the prior positions of the symbols is filed with Chart Letter 158 (1948).
