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Of this part left in pencil, the Launch-work does not agree with the Boat-work, the difference being about 3 feet, and it is impossible to say which depth is right and which wrong.

The survey of it is, moreover, incomplete, all coves and Head-waters being left unfinished as also more work is wanted around the numerous rocks and ledges in order to develop them well so as to be able to draw the curves.

For these reasons I suggest that this sheet, as far as the soundings are plotted, be accepted and of the upper part beyond the narrows a re-survey be made.
