Descriptive Report of
Kahului Harbor Approaches

From Kahului Harbor the Coast trends N.W. by N. to Kahakuloa Point eight miles. This Coast is formed by rocky cliffs several hundred feet high and is fringed with numerous coral reefs, causing the swell to break heavily. Five and one fourth miles to the Southward and Eastward of Kahakuloa Point a reef extends off shore three fourths of a mile. The sea breaks on the end of this reef in four fathoms of water with an ordinary swell on.

From Kahului Harbor the Coast trends about E.N.E. nine miles. For three miles to the Eastward of Kahului this shore is fringed by an extensive coral reef with from 1/2 to 2 fathoms of water in it and extending one half mile off shore when it drops off suddenly into 20 fathoms of water.
