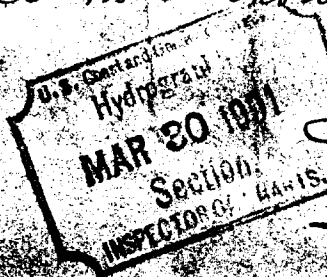

No. 18. TREASURY DEPARTMENT

This sheet shows that the channel of Delaware River from the northern extremity of Chester Island to the west end of Tinicum Island, near buoy No 33, has narrowed about 300 feet, more or less, and that a decided bar has formed between buoy No 33 and the H.S. buoy to the westward of it. Though the 24 foot curve still shows a ~~few~~ channel of 25 feet. It is impracticable being too narrow and crooked and 23 feet only can safely be carried over the place where sheet 126 now shows 5 fathoms.
