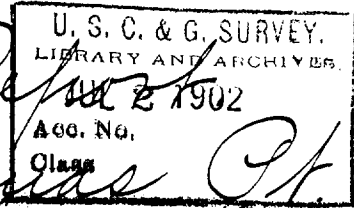

Descriptive Report
St. Guayanes to Yaguas Pt.



This sheet embraces Yabucoa Bay, containing the village, Playa de Yabucoa, or Port Yabucoa. Yabucoa itself is several miles inland, a town of considerable importance. It has postal and telegraphic facilities. Its commerce is carried on by way of the Port, by means of steamers and schooners.

The Bay is dangerous on account of reefs and shoals but has a good anchorage when it has been reached. It is open to southerly gales and sea. The inner shore is

flat and sandy, while the sides of the Bay are rocky.
