The work on this sheet is good. The verification developed nothing of importance, only a few slight errors. At beginning of work lead lines were used for two weeks without adjustment.


Reduction of soundings not well verified. Some soundings as plotted not according to elapsed time. No mention in record of variation in speed of launch between positions.

Survey in vicinity of wharves, docks, etc. should be in greater detail, at least give depth alongside.

The note explaining failure of lines to cross in Union Bay should appear on the sheet. Character of bottom rarely given in deep water.
