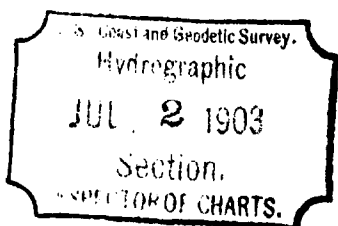

The work on this is very satisfactory. Verification revealed few errors and none of importance.

Every determination of boat's position, whether by sextant angles or other means, should be numbered to facilitate the use of records.

The survey in the vicinity of wharves, docks, etc., should be in greater detail and more precise. In such work better results are had when positions are determined by means of tape measurements in connection with a large scale sketch of the water front. Character of bottom rarely given in deep water.
