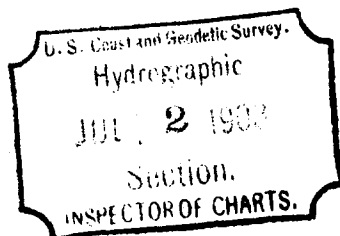
Except in a few minor details this work seems to meet all the requirements.

Variations of speed of sounding boat should be noted. Recorder should make special effort to avoid mistaking "seven" for "eleven".

Every determination of boat's position, whether by sextant angles or other means, should be numbered.

Survey in vicinity of wharves, docks, etc. should be in greater detail and more precise. At least, give depth alongside. Character of bottom rarely given in deep water.
