Point Arenas Bank to Mosquito Reef

The area covered by this sheet is a re-survey made for the purpose of ascertaining the existence or non-existence of a reported shoal. The examination was made with the "Channel Sweep" and soundings with two leads. No indication of a shoal was found and no material changes in the depth of water from that shown from previous surveys. During this examination a man was stationed at the foremast head on the lookout for shoal water, but no indications were reported.
