- 3. This Cove can be utilized as an anchorage during Kona (southerly and southwesterly) weather only, otherwise a swell rolls in.
- 4. The geographical positions of the triangulation stations plotted on this sheet are from a triangulation executed by the Patterson's Party during the season on which this hydrography was executed. The initual points of this triangulation was based on the Hawaiian Covernment Trinometric Survey.

- 2. Tides were recorded continuously at Conradt's Gove, Kahoolawe Island from November 7th to December 21, 1904, and from January 23rd to March 1, 1905., with Automatic Tide Gauge No. 69, scale 1/6.
- 3. This cove received its name from the fact that opium smugglers from Victoria, B.C. used, during the last two dynasties, to smuggle opium ashore at this place and secret it. With light northeasterly winds this place can be used as an anchorage.
- 4. The geographical positions of the triangulation stations plotted on this sheet are from a triangulation executed by the Patterson's Party during the season on which

this hydrography was executed. The initual points of this triangulation was based on the Hawaiian Government Trig-nometric Survey.

5. A table of the geographical positions of the topographic and hydrographic points, as determined with the planetable, is attached to the descriptive report of the Topographic Sheet of Kahoolawe Island.


