- 1. The records conform to the requirements of the General Instructions, except for the omission of the descriptive report. The writing in the sounding records is too faint and often carelessly done. The frequent use of the work "same" where names of signals are repeated is objectionable.
- 2. The plan and character of development conform to the requirements of the General Instructions.
- The plan and extent of development satisfy the specific instructions.
- 4. The sounding line crossings are adequate.
- 5. The information is sufficient for drawing the usual depth curves.
- 6. The field plotting was completed to the extent prescribed in the General Instructions.
- 7. The character of the junction with the adjoining survey cannot be stated as the latter has not yet been plotted.
- 8. No further leadline surveying is required within the area of the sheet. There are several places however which should be dragged.
- 9. The character and scope of the surveying and field drafting are excellent.
